1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

- Deutscher Segler Verband (DSV)
- Kieler Yacht-Club (KYC)
- Yacht Club Strande (YCS)
- Deutsches Drachengeschwader (DDG)

The Regatta Office is located at the "Dragon Lounge" (shipyard hall of the Kieler Yacht-Club), Strandstraße 10, 24229 Strande.

2. RULES

- 2.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2009-2012. The "Ordnungsvorschriften Regattasegeln des DSV" including the "Meisterschaftsordnung" (MO), the International Dragon Association Class Rules (the article 13.30 will apply), this Notice of Race, the Sailing Instructions and annexed rules shall apply.
- 2.2. If there is a conflict between this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the text of the Sailing-Instructions shall prevail.

3. ADVERTISING

- 3.1. This regatta is classified category A as per rule 20.3.2 of the ISAF (RRS). Paragraph (d) (i) of rule 20.3.1 will also apply.

4. ELIGIBILITY

- 4.1. Entries will be accepted as adjusted in the "Meisterschaftsordnung (MO) des DSV".
- 4.2. ISAF eligibility requirements under RRS shall apply.
- 4.3. Only International Dragons which hold valid Measurement Certificates shall compete. The valid registration/ measurement certificate shall be presented to the organizers at the time of Check In at Strande.
- 4.4. Every German Crewmember has to register at the Website of DSV ([HYPERLINK "http://www.dsv.org" www.dsv.org](http://www.dsv.org)).

5. ENTRY

- 5.1. Internet: Online-entries via Internet (www.kyc.de) will be accepted. KYC shall be authorized to collect the entry fee electronically.
- 5.2. The entry has to be submitted by the current OWNER of the yacht (NOT the helmsman).
- 5.3. Entry close on June 02, 2009.

6. ENTRY FEE

- 6.1. The entry fee is 390,00 Euro.
- 6.2. This entry fee includes: the launching at the beginning and hauling out at the end of the regatta, berthing from July 12 to July 18, After Race Drinks & Snacks, Entry Fee for the CHILDHOOD Race, and the CHILDHOOD Farewell and Champions' Evening as well as Green fee for Sailors' Golf.

- 7.2. Depending on the number of entries the race committee may decide if all participants shall sail in one fleet/ one start or if groups will be formed and started as two fleets/ two starts. In the case of one fleet max. 7 races are scheduled. In the case of group sailing more than 7 races may be scheduled and the number of required races shall apply to MO 10.

8. MEASUREMENTS

- 8.1 There will be a measurement check on Saturday and Sunday.
8.2. In addition to RRS 78.2 the measurement certificate might be inspected throughout the event.
8.3 No more than 8 sails may be submitted for measurement.

9. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 9.1. The Sailing Instructions and the Notice of Race will be available at the Check In.

10. COURSES

- 10.1. The courses will be defined in the Sailing Instructions.

11. PENALTY SYSTEM

- 11.1. Decisions of the international jury will be final as provided in rule 70.5.

12. SCORING

- 12.1. The low point scoring system will apply at WR Appendix A.
12.2 Discard will apply at MO 10 (If more than 4 up to 7 races have been completed a yacht's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. In case of group sailing and the number of discards shall apply to MO 10. The final definition will be published in the sailing instructions).

13. TRAINER/ SUPPORT BOATS

- 13.1. Before racing, trainer/ support boats shall be registered at the Check In and have to pay the harbour fee directly to the official harbour master Strande.

14. BERTHING

- 14.1. Yachts shall be kept in their assigned places in the harbour.

15. HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

- 15.1. All yachts shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the jury.

16. RADIO COMMUNICATION

- 16.1. A yacht shall neither make radio transmission while racing nor receive radio communication not available to all yachts. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

17. PRIZES

- 17.1. Daily prizes for the yachts 1 to 3 will be awarded.
17.2. Additional special prizes and perpetual trophies will be listed in the programme.
17.3 Diploma and Plaques from the DSV for the 1st to the 6th Place in the Dragon Class.
17.4 The winner takes the title "Internationaler Deutscher Meister/ Internationale Deutsche Meisterin der Dracheklasse 2009".

18. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 18.1. Limitation of liability – cognovits clause. The responsibility for the decision of a coxswain to participate in a race or to continue with it is solely with him; to that extent he also takes the responsibility for his crew. The coxswain is responsible for the qualification and the correct nautical conduct of his crew as well as for the suitability and the transport-safe condition of the registered boat. In cases of Force Majeure or on grounds of administrative orders or for safety reasons, the organizer is entitled to make changes in the realization of the event or to cancel the event. In these cases there does not exist any liability for compensation of the organizer to the participant. In case of a violation of obligations that do not constitute primary respectively material contractual duties (cardinal obligations), the liability of the organizer, no matter because of which cause in law, for material and property damages of all kinds and their consequences that arise to the participant during or in connection with the participation in the event resulting from a conduct of the organizer, his representatives, servants or agents, is restricted to damages that were caused wilfully or grossly negligent. When a violation of cardinal obligations occurs, in cases of simple negligence the liability of the organizer is limited to

foreseeable, typically occurring damages. To the extent that the liability for damages of the organizer is excluded or restricted, the participant also relieves the staff – employees and representatives, agents, servants, sponsors and individuals who provide or drive salvage, safety or rescue vessels or assist with their use – from the individual liability for damages, as well as also all other individuals who were instructed to act in connection with the realization of the event. The effective racing rules of the ISAF, the administrative regulations regatta sailing and the articles of association of the DSV, the class rules as well as the regulations of the invitation to the competition and the sailing instructions are to be complied with and are expressly recognized.

18.2. The German law shall prevail.

19. INSURANCE

19.1. Each participating yacht shall be insured with valid (and for the racing area suitable) third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 1.500.000 Euro per event or the equivalent. The organizers will require a written proof of insurance at the time of registration.

21. ORGANIZATION

21.1. Sufficient parking space for cars is available near the Harbour Strande.

21.2. It is not permitted to leave cars and trailers in the harbour area.

21.3. Cranes: yachts arriving by trailer shall be launched and hauled out by the cranes in the Harbour Strande only. During the event a craning fee for one launching and one haul-out is included in the entry fee.

21.4. Moorings in the Harbour Strande, harbour fee during the period from July 12- July 18 is included in the entry fee.
